### "Community" v. "Group" - Survival of the closest

Though not the only question, one question you could ask about a community versus a group is which one survives better. My vote: group. Let's look at both arguments.

Community to me constitutes a collection of individuals with a shared interest. I think of my freshman RA's wanting to "bring a sense of community" to the dorm to test this definition, and it holds up. To me the word "community" evokes the image of something large, as if to tell individuals who are passionate about or believe in certain things that in the vast world exists a bundle or bundles of people who share that same passion or belief. It's almost like an over arching category that you can fit into if you choose to, a category whose components are all connected by the same thread which gives community power in numbers. That's argument 1.

Argument 2: A group is a smaller collection of individuals but more than sharing a common interest, the individuals in a group know one another. Members of a group learn about both their commonalities and their differences. Being closer to each other than people in a community, in my opinion, proves groups are tighter knit and more able to withstand external pressures.

Thoughts? Does close-knit or strength in numbers win?
