And 'Abyssinia' is the ancient name of Ethiopia and the region known today as Horn of Africa.

2000 Habesha Cultural Restaurant is along the city's main road, Bole, and is situated in a tukul, a traditional hut with low wooden tables. Ethiopian cuisine is served without silverware, as the custom is to eat with one's hands. One of the specialties here is injera, (made from tef, a sour-wheat-like grain, mixed with cool water and a touch of yeast, it has a spongy consistency), served with sautéed spinach, caramelized onions, spicy potatoes, red peppers, an assortment of raw beef cubes, and several vegetarian options. Eating injera is a celebration of the Ethiopian grains and produce as much as it is a sensory feast. The restaurant also has traditional dancing every evening at 20:00.
